Trailer Maintenance and Deployment Committee: POC Steve KO4AFL

- Club, educational and promotional use.
- Request for trailer use to be submitted to the committee 60-90 days in advance.
- Work left to be done:
 - Mount propane tanks after continued floor repair (weld frame "C" channel support)
 - TW suggested we mount the two tanks on the tongue and buy a cover for them. Steve advised against having that much weight on the tongue.
 - o Some rust spots noted on the trailer frame and needs to be removed
 - Small dehumidifier for the trailer: The membership approved \$350 for a dehumidifier. Consider providing Glenn a stipend to use his outdoor outlet.
 - GPS repeater \$80 approved: Need to mount antenna on the roof upright.
 - Solar panels and charge controller have been mounted. Need to run conduit through the roof and into the trailer electrical system.

 was so positive with the students. They would like us to teach them about Integrated
 Circuits and have them build a Siren Sound Generator on March 17,18 or 19. We have
 at least 6 TARC volunteers signed us for both the PCB class and the breadboard class.
